

Distribution report SOLAR lights UNHCR SO Arua, Uganda

UNHCR SO Arua received 50 SOLAR lights, for distributing in the four settlements in its area of operation.

It was decided that the solar lights would be distributed according to the number of beneficiaries per settlement.

The statistics as of October 2006 were as follows:

Ikafe settlement: 9,943 individuals = 16,47% = 8 solar lights

Imvepi settlement: 23,501 individuals = 38,93% = 19 solar lights

Madi Okollo settlement: 7,996 individuals = 13,25% = 7 solar lights

Rhino Camp settlement: 18,925 individuals = 31,35% = 16 solar lights

The Senior Field Clerk for Madi Okollo requested two extra solar lights, which brings the total for Madi Okollo to 9, and for Ikafe to 6.

UNHCR discussed the distribution with the different implementing and operational partners in the settlements, and after that the solar lights were given to the following beneficiaries:

Ikafe settlement, a total number of 6 lights

- 1 to UNHCR protection case
- 3 to multi-functional drop-in centres (SGBV survivors)
- 2 to girls who achieve the best results for their Primary Leaving Examinations

Imvepi settlement, a total number of 19 lights

- 5 to students in Imvepi Secondary Self Help School
- 3 to UNHCR protection cases
- 3 to school going unaccompanied minors living in groups
- 1 to Imvepi health centre, where the solar panel has not been functioning
- 3 to multi-functional drop-in centres (SGBV survivors)
- 4 for people with specific needs, identified by UNHCR and the Community Services implementing partner

Madi Okollo settlement, a total number of 9 lights

- 2 to UNHCR protection cases
- 6 to school going un-accompanied minors living in groups
- 1 to the woman who is fostering a malnourished and dehydrated baby

Rhino Camp settlement, a total number of 16 lights

- 3 to UNHCR protection cases
- 13 to students in Quiver Secondary Self Help School
